Section Chief Jay Widby called the meeting to order and led the group in the Obligation. Following the Obligation, Section Secretary Jason Laney called the roll. Without objection, Mr. Widby commented that if anyone has any comments or suggestions about how to improve the Dixie for next year, please contact Section Chief Jason Laney at jhlaney@aol.com. Mr. Widby also said that the totem pole judging would occur immediately following the COC, and each lodge adviser must serve as a judge if no name was submitted ahead of time.

Without objection, Mr. Widby moved the meeting into the Spirit Award. He commented that each lodge would receive only one vote for the award. The Spirit Award winner was Atta Kulla Kulla lodge.

Without objection, Mr. Widby turned the floor over to Andy Clark for a few quick remarks. Mr. Clark said that the host lodge will check each campsite and every lodge needs at least two members in their campsite. All gear should be moved to the dining fly, gear will be brought down to the base of camp, and a shuttle will be running to dead storage. Tripp Clark asked him to please repeat the first part of his announcement.

Without objection, Mr. Widby moved the meeting into the old business. There was no old business.

Without objection, Mr. Widby moved the meeting into the new business. Chad Dryer said that Camp John J. Barnhardt has a lone scout museum. **He moved to sell patches at the museum during the Dixie 2001 fellowship to raise money for the lone scout program; the patches will have Dixie 2001 printed on the patch; will only be sold at the museum and not at the trading post; and all profits from the patch sales will be kept by the museum. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.**

Mr. Widby turned the floor over the Christopher Maxey, section webmaster. Mr. Maxey said that there have been several problems with the section site: long access time deters people, URL is long, and current set-up does not allow any interactive work. **He moved to move the SR 5 site to www.SR5.org, create e-mail addresses to this domain name, the web server would be softcom.com and the server costs \$9.95 a month with no strings attached, and authorize the section key three bargaining power for the site.** Jonathan Malfors asked how will the section pay for the site? Mr. Maxey said that the money would come out of the section's operating budget. James Worley asked when will the web site be up and running? Mr. Maxey said that it will be up as soon as the financial matters can be handled. **The motion was carried unanimously.**

Mr. Widby recognized Mr. Clark for one final announcement. He said that participation pins will be given to each lodge adviser for dispersal to lodge members.

Without objection, Mr. Widby moved the meeting into the Section Adviser's Minute. Following the Section Adviser's Minute, the meeting was adjourned.
