Section Chief Jason Laney called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. on Friday, April 27, 2001. He discussed the particular form of parliamentary procedure that would be used during the meeting. Section Secretary John Garwood called the roll. Without objection Mr. Laney moved into the 2001 Dixie Fellowship portion of the agenda.

Jeremy Cawley, Dixie Vice Chief, welcomed everyone to the 2001 Dixie Fellowship. He discussed any changes in the schedule and locations of activities. He also asked each key 3 to see Chuck Bowman, Dixie Adviser, for the slip to buy staff memorabilia. Without objection, Mr. Laney moved into the Shows portion of the agenda.

Brian Simpson, Shows Coordinator, discussed the lodge involvement in the shows. He also discussed safety concerns for the shows. Without objection, Mr. Laney moved into the Indian Events portion of the agenda.

Justin Sill, Indian Events Coordinator, discussed the sheets required to be turned in at the Judges meeting. He then went over where all the Indian Events locations were going to be held. Without objection, Mr. Laney moved into the Program portion of the meeting

Jeremy Christie, Program Coordinator, discussed the Section sponsored Quest events and their locations. He asked that the Eswau Huppeday judges review the obstacle course before it got dark. He also went over the penalties for the obstacle course. Without objection, Mr. Laney moved into the Training portion of the agenda.

Matt Smith, Training Coordinator, discussed the need for lodges to distribute their members to each training session due to limited seating. He also requested that participants with chairs to bring their chairs with them to the training sessions. He discussed any location changes and rain sites. Fred Descy, Muscogee Lodge Chief, raised a concern over a rain site. Mr. Smith discussed the Adviser's pow-wow as well. Without objection, Mr. Laney moved into the Administration portion of the agenda.

Jeff Womack, Administration Coordinator, discussed the location for the judging of the administrative competitions. He also discussed the periods that the Lodge Displays were to be set up and taken down. Mr. Laney then had each trainer to tell where the judging sheets were to be turned in. Without objection, Mr. Laney moved into the Section Officer Election Procedure Portion of the meeting.

Mr. Laney discussed the time limit on speeches and the articles for the Saturday evening newsletter. He also discussed voting procedure for the election.

Mr. Laney introduced Jason Kemp, Southern Region Chief. Mr. Kemp discussed the National and Regional programs coming in 2001. The Southern Region has created a new program that if any lodge chief gets 5 or more Arrowmen to participate in the Wilderness Voyage program his fee would be paid by the Region. He also discussed the OA staff positions still available at the 2001 National Jamboree.

Mr. Descy asked where lodges should turn in the rotating plaques. Mr. Laney answered his question.

Paul Culp, Itibapishe Iti Hollo Lodge Chief, moved to place an odd colored staff t-shirt in the silent auction with proceeds going to the Host Lodge. Michael Kirby, Atta Kulla Kulla Lodge Chief, seconded the motion. Mr. Kirby said that the money should go to the Host Lodge. Jeremy Christie, Skyuka Lodge Chief, asked why it should go to the Host Lodge. Mr. Culp answered the question. A hand vote was taken and it resulted in a 5 to 5 tie. Bill Barry, Tsali Lodge Chief, asked why it was going to the Host Lodge. Chase Iseman, Santee Lodge Chief, said it was about the budget. **The motion passed by Mr. Laney's deciding vote.**

Without objection, Mr. Laney adjourned the meeting.
