Mr. Bajan called on Joe Dorsey, 2006 Service Lodge Coordinator (a.k.a. Dixie Vice-Chief), to talk about the Service Lodge portion of the meeting. Mr. Dorsey welcomed everyone to Knox Scout Reservation. He said that his lodge came together over the last year to get their camp ready for Dixie. Mr. Dorsey thanked everyone for complying with the one car per campsite rule and for coming to the Dixie Fellowship.

Brian Manuel, Lodge Chief of Eswau Huppeday Lodge, asked about the posted speed limit throughout camp. Mr. Dorsey clarified that 15 mph is the camp-wide speed limit.

Mr. Bajan called on Adam Holbrook, 2006 Dixie Shows Coordinator, to talk about the Friday night show. Mr. Holbrook told the lodge chiefs that they would be in the evening show and should wear an undershirt they could get messy.

Mr. Bajan called on Greg Bajan, 2006 American Indian Events Coordinator, to talk about the American Indian Events portion of the meeting. Greg called on lodges to confirm which ceremonies they would be competing in. Greg stated that he would use that information to randomize the order of ceremony competition and let lodges know the order of competition that night at the judges' meeting. Clyde Davis, Lodge Adviser of Skyuka Lodge, asked when the latest was their lodge could change their mind about ceremonies. Greg responded anytime up to the Friday night show. Greg asked that any further questions that come up about American Indian Events be directed to himself or James Barton, American Indian Coordinator Adviser.

Ryan Bajan called on Adam Kuykendall, 2006 Program Coordinator, to talk about the Program portion of the meeting. Mr. Kuykendall had Frank Sturges, 2006 SR-5 Section Vice-Chief and Training Coordinator, hand out a map of Quest for the Golden Arrow Competition sites, the Tug-o-War competition bracket, and the Ultimate Frisbee competition bracket. He explained that the change of Tug-o-War location was because of muddy conditions at the original site. Mr. Kuykendall stressed that lodges must have enough judges for each event, and that they should not be late for the program judges' meeting that evening. He stated that in the Tomahawk Throw event, there was a physical change in the event set up. Mr. Kuykendall made a friendly amendment for the competition guidelines to read "five (5)" instead of "three (3)" targets in Section II.D.9.d. of the 2006 Dixie Fellowship Guidelines. Travis Wood, Lodge Chief of Skyuka Lodge, seconded. Without objection, Mr. Bajan allowed the motion to carry and continued to the Training portion of the meeting.

Mr. Bajan called on Frank Sturges to talk about the Training portion of the meeting. Mr. Sturges told them about training location cluster, noted as "Knowledge and Training" on the map in the Delegate Passport. He stated that the training judges' meeting would be in the Jimmie Dyess Pavillion. He asked for questions about the training. Mr. Sturges asked lodges to get stamps after the meeting for their trainers to stamp passports at their training sessions. William McCormick, Lodge Chief of Muscogee Lodge, asked about returning the stamps. Mr. Sturges said that immediately after the training, trainers could find himself in the Knowledge and Training area to return the stamps. Tim Grismer, Lodge Adviser of Itibapishe Iti Hollo Lodge, asked about power in the training tents. Mr. Sturges listed lodges that had requested power and would have it provided to them.

Mr. Bajan called on Mason Thomas, 2006 Administration Coordinator, to talk about the Administration portion of the meeting. Mr. Thomas asked for judges' names to be submitted after the meeting and stated that the administration judges' meeting would

be in the breezeway of the Administration Building. He asked for a list of competitions they would be competing in to be submitted after the meeting as well. Mr. Davis asked about location of lodge displays. Mr. Thomas responded that they could be set up in the open areas around the enclosed areas of the Administration Building. Mr. McCormick asked about the time displays should be setup. Mr. Thomas responded that they should be set up by 9:15 a.m. on Saturday morning.

Mr. Bajan highlighted portions of the SR-5 Section Officer Elections Procedures in the guidelines. He reminded everyone that candidates would have three minutes per speech. He stated that articles for the Saturday evening newsletter should be submitted to Trey Courtney, SR-5 Section Secretary Adviser, after the meeting. Mr. Bajan said that nominations would be accepted at Friday evening, Saturday morning, and Saturday afternoon assemblies, as well as the Saturday evening show. He stated that page 10 of the Delegate Passport has the location of the judges' meetings.

Mr. Bajan called on Mr. Kuykendall, who added that the Tug-o-War weigh-in would be at 8:00 am at the Administration Building.

Mr. Bajan called on Greg Bajan, who added that judges should bring their American Indian Events forms filled out by lodges to the judges' meeting.

Ryan Bajan called on Mac McLean, SR-5 Section Adviser. Mr. McLean thanked the service lodge, section officers, and Key 3's for their hard work, and said that he looked forward to a great weekend.

Mr. Bajan informed everyone of the location of the section office in the Administration Building and asked for lodges to return rotating plaques.

Mr. Bajan called on Mr. Dorsey, who added that COC members that want to buy up to two service lodge flaps should see Rick Mann, Lodge Adviser of Bob White Lodge.

Mr. Bajan called on David Surrett, Lodge Adviser of Santee Lodge, who announced that one more lodge that would like to ride with them to NOAC should see him or Tim Hunt, Lodge Adviser of Atta Kulla Kulla Lodge.

Without objection, Mr. Bajan moved to adjourn the meeting following the OA song. Mr. Bajan led members in the OA song, and the meeting was adjourned at 7:38 p.m.
